### *KINDERGARTEN*

- 1 package of red checking pens (not erasable)
- 1 package of highlighters

- 1 box of washable markers (boys only)
- 1 box of thin washable markers (girls only)
- 12 glue sticks
- 1 package of wide-ruled loose leaf notebook paper
- 2 boxes of tissues
- 1 package of baby wipes or antibacterial wipes
- 1 box of gallon size ziplock bags (boys only)
- 1 box of quart size ziplock bags (girls only)
- 2 bottles 8oz or larger hand sanitizer (boys only)
- 1 can Lysol spray (girls only)

### *SIXTH, SEVENTH AND EIGHTH GRADES*

Being prepared each and every day is part of the students' organizational grade. Please assist your child in being prepared with pencils, pens, paper, etc.

**Teachers do NOT supply students with calculators, pencils or paper.**

Students should complete all work in blue or black ink unless colored ink is requested by the teacher. No work should be completed using color ink (pink, green, purple, etc.) unless specifically requested.

**Sharpies and other permanent markers are prohibited and should not be in students' possession.**

**For the classrooms: (Please bring to the middle school building science room.)**

- 6<sup>th</sup> grade – 2 packs dry erase markers
- 7<sup>th</sup> grade - colored pencils and one box of disposable latex gloves
- 8<sup>th</sup> grade – washable markers and one box of disposable latex gloves
- 1 pack of glue sticks
- 1 box of facial tissues
- one rectangular box of disinfecting wipes
- 3 rolls of paper towels
- 1 bottle of hand sanitizer

**For the students to have with them throughout every day:**

- **memory stick – 256 or higher**
- Blue and/or black and red ball point pens
- #2 pencils – standard or mechanical
- Loose leaf paper
- Erasers
- Highlighters
- One scientific calculator - TI-30 or TI-34 suggested
- 3- 1' Binder (1 Math/1 Science/6<sup>th</sup> L.A.)
- 2 sets of Dividers (1 Math/1 Science)
- 5 Star Notebook with pockets (Social Studies)
- 1 folder (Social Studies)

- 5- 1” Binder Rings (Social Studies)

- 1 pkg. of red and green pens (6<sup>th</sup> L.A.)
- 3 composition notebooks (7<sup>th</sup> L.A.)

**For students to have when needed:**

- ¼ “ square graph paper
- “dry line” style correction tape – **NO liquid white out allowed!**
- Markers and/or colored pencils
- Construction paper
- Poster paper
- 1 dozen sharpened #2 pencils

\*Middle School is an excellent opportunity for students to learn and develop their personal organizational style. Some flexibility will be allowed yet students must learn to organize efficiently and not carry all of their belongings with them daily.

### *NINTH GRADE*

- Two plastic accordion style expandable file folders with at least 5-pockets each (to be kept primarily at home)
- Five plastic duo-tang folders (each with 3-prongs and 2-pockets)
- Composition book
- Three packs of 3x5 index cards
- Compass (plastic only)
- Protractor

- 12” ruler (with metric increments)
- One scientific calculator
- Graph paper 1/4” square
- “dry-line” style correction tape (NO liquid white out)
- Two or more dry erase markers
- Markers or colored pencils and construction paper (to be kept at home)
- Blue and/or black ball point pens\* and red ballpoint pens\*
- Loose leaf paper\*
- Number two pencils (mechanical preferred)\*
- Erasers\*
- Highlighters\*
- Two boxes of tissues (one for specialists classes)

**Please note:**

- The supplies marked with an asterisk (\*) are needed in all classes and will need to be replenished throughout the year. Extra boxes of tissues, disinfecting wipes and paper towels are always needed and appreciated.
- Please note that students are not permitted to complete work in colored ink other than blue or black (i.e. no pink, purple, green, etc.). Also note that Sharpie (or other permanent) markers are prohibited and should not be in the students’ possession at anytime.
- Label all supplies (except those marked as do not label) with student’s name in permanent marker.
- Send supplies in on the first day of school.
- Specialists may require additional school supplies after school begins.
- No rolling backpacks as per school handbook.
- No zippered 3-ring binders
